

SPINK COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD  
March 5, 2013

The Spink County Drainage Board met Tuesday March 5, 2013 at 10:00 am with board members Dave Albrecht, Jeff Albrecht, Pat Kramp, and Craig Johnson present. Also in attendance were Kimberly Markley Drainage Administrator, Jim Millar, Precision Soils, Donald Masat and Larry Tebben, Emergency Manager.

Motion was made by Pat Kramp to approve agenda seconded by Jeff Albrecht. Motion carried. Motion was made by Craig Johnson to approve minutes from December 4, 2012. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding Donald Masat's project and township supervisors' signatures for a drainage permit. It was the consensus of the board if all three supervisors' signatures could not be obtained that a favorable motion from a township board meeting would be required. It was the consensus of the board that we are asking the township board if they foresee problems with road right of ways or culverts.

Jim Millar of Precision Soils was present to discuss possible ordinance changes. Discussion was held on adding a form for township supervisor signatures, 1/8 mile buffer, adding # acres to be drained to the permit, changes to requirements depending upon the waterway that the project drains into, installed map requirements. Mr. Millar shared a portion of the Beadle County ordinance. The board will discuss these issues again on March 26, 2013.

Motion was by Craig Johnson to adjourn as Spink County Drainage Board and reconvene as Spink County Commissioners, second by Pat Kramp. Motion Carried.
