

Spink County Drainage Board

The Spink County Drainage Board met April 14, 2020 at 9:45 with board members David Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Suzanne Smith, Brett Knox, Dustin Rische and Diane Tipton Drainage administrator. Motion was made by Brian Johnson, seconded by Brett Knox to recess as Board of Commissioners and convene as Drainage Board. All voted Aye. Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the agenda seconded by Brett Knox. All voted Aye. Suzanne Smith made a motion to approve the minutes from March 17, 2020 seconded by Dustin Rische.

Discussion was held on issuing a letter for Jeff Haessig, Highway Superintendent, from the drainage board giving him the authority to assess and determine the need for placement, replacement and repair of culverts in the Spink County Road system. Motion by Suzanne Smith, seconded by Brett Knox to issue the letter. All voted Aye.

Discussion on Dakota Access Pipeline project to restore natural water flow with culvert and dirt work on their property in Section 7-115-63 Crandon twp. Motion by Suzann Smith, seconded by Brian Johnson to approve this project. All voted Aye.

Discussion on project in Lake twp. to install riser pipe in ditch along twp. road 179th Street and 180th Street to drain water from roads and make them usable. Lake twp. issued a letter in support of this project. Suzanne Smith made a motion to approve this project, seconded by Brian Johnson. All voted aye.

Jeff discussed a drainage issue in Athol Twp. The commissioners determined he should assess the problem and correct it.

Meeting adjourned as Drainage Board and reconvened as Spink County Zoning at 9:55 AM.
