

Spink County Spring Load Restrictions: All oil roads plus 6 miles of gravel on County Road #4 from State 37 east to county line will be posted at 6 ton and 40 mph.

Spring Load Restrictions are in effect when weight limit signs are in place on county roads. This generally coincides with East River State Load Restrictions but will depend on local conditions at the discretion of the Highway Superintendent, approximately the first week of March.

- Spink County Rd #3 = From State Hwy 212 south 18 miles

- Spink County Rd #11 = From State Hwy 212 north 25 miles
- Spink County Rd #11 = From State Hwy 212 south to County 20, 3 miles

- Spink County Rd #12 = From State Hwy 37 west 11 miles
- Spink County Rd #13 = From State Hwy 28 north 7 miles
- Spink County Rd #14 = From State Hwy 281 east 10 miles

- Spink County Rd #17 = From State Hwy 20 north 6 miles
- Spink County Rd #18 = From State Hwy 212 south 1 mile
- Spink County Rd #18 = From State Hwy 281 east 1 mile
- Spink County Rd #18 = From State Hwy 281 west 9 miles
- Spink County Rd #19 = From State Hwy 20 north 7 miles
- Spink County Rd #19 = From State Hwy 212 north 8 miles
- Spink County Rd #24 = From State Hwy 281 east 10 miles
