

**SPINK COUNTY COMMISSION PROCEEDINGS
REDFIELD, SOUTH DAKOTA**

The Spink County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, February 3, 2026, at the Spink County Courthouse. Present were Commissioners Dave Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Brett Knox, Kevin Siebrecht, and Suzanne Smith. Chairman Brian Johnson opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADOPT AGENDA

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Siebrecht, to adopt the agenda. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES APPROVED

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2026 Commission meeting. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

CPI

Theresa Hodges, Auditor, reported the Consumer Price Index(CPI) received from the SD Department of Revenue for 2026 taxes payable in 2027 as 2.5%.

SUPPORTED ENTITIES

Financial statements from the following supported entities were filed: NESDCAP dba GROW South Dakota, Area IV Nutrition, Ginny's Safehouse, Glacial Lakes & Prairie Tourism., Spink County Historical Society, Spink County Ambulance, Spink County Conservation District, Spink County Transit, Senior Citizen Council, Conde Ambulance, and Reflections Recovery Home.

SHERIFF

Jenna Appel, Sheriff, filed an employee resignation letter, two maintenance contracts, an amended subscription contract for in car video systems and cloud storage due to upgrading in-vehicle cameras, and a grant equipment purchase quote. Appel will look into a possible multi-year contract for the Voice Products maintenance contract and report back.

PERSONNEL

Motion was made by Knox, seconded by Siebrecht, to accept the resignation of John Miller, part-time Deputy Sheriff, effective 2/3/26. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

MAINTENANC CONTRACT

Motion was made by Albrecht, seconded by Siebrecht, to approve the Idemia Identity & Security livescan maintenance and support contract for the period of 12/21/25-12/2026 at a cost of \$3,358. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

CONTRACT/GRANT EQUIPMENT

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to approve Digital Ally's quote of \$10,012 for the purchase of two EVO-HD in-vehicle cameras, with the Highway Safety Grant award an 80/20 grant, and the amended subscription contract with Digital-Ally for years 3, 4 and 5, removing 2 DVM-800 in-vehicle cameras licenses. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Chairman Johnson recognized Sheriff Jenna Appel as a recipient of the 2026 South Dakota Sheriffs' Service Award.

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT

Jeff Haessig, Highway Superintendent, requested hiring IMEG Corporation for bridge inspections and requested to advertise for supply bids

RESOLUTION FOR BRIDGE REINSPECTION PROGRAM(#26-11)

WHEREAS, Title 23, Section 151, United States Code and Title 23, Part 650, Subpart C, Code of Federal Regulations, requires initial inspection of all bridges and reinspection at intervals not to exceed two years with the exception of reinforced concrete box culverts that meet specific criteria. These culverts are reinspected at intervals not to exceed four years.

THEREFORE, Spink County is desirous of participating in the Bridge Inspection Program using Bridge Replacement funds.

The County requests SDDOT to hire IMEG Corporation for the inspection work. SDDOT will secure federal approvals, make payments to the Consulting Engineer for inspection services rendered, and bill the County for 20% of the cost. The County will be responsible for the required 20% matching funds.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Siebrecht, to adopt the above resolution. All members voted aye. Motion carried.
