The Spink County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, May 5, 2026, at the Spink County Courthouse. Present were Commissioners Dave Albrecht, Brian Johnson, Brett Knox, Kevin Siebrecht, and Suzanne Smith. Chairman Brian Johnson opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADOPT AGENDA

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Knox, to adopt the agenda with the addition of a welfare application and courthouse roof replacement downpayment request. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES APPROVED

Motion was made by Siebrecht, seconded by Smith, to approve the minutes of the April 28, 2026 Commission meeting. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

ABATEMENT APPLICATION

Motion was made by Knox, seconded by Albrecht, to approve the Application for Abatement of Property Taxes for the property described as Lots 18-20, Meadow Park Estates, Redfield City, Spink County, SD, abating \$609.20 of 2025 taxes pay 2026 due to an error on the assessed valuation. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

WIC CONTRACT
